STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City requires periodic crane services at various locations throughout the City. Crane rental equipment services are critical necessities on meeting the daily objectives to maintain safe roadway conditions, flood channels and detention basin, and various Building Maintenance Projects Citywide.

Public Works Roadway Maintenance Department solicited 3 quotes for the crane rental services. Atlas Crane, Dielco Crane Service, Inc., and Reliable Crane Service. Atlas Crane was the lowest most responsive and responsible vendor, and is properly licensed.

Heavy equipment rental being use for the Flood maintenance program is reimbursed by the Clark County Regional Flood Control District.
