STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of North Las Vegas has proposed an amendment to the City of North Las Vegas Municipal Code, Title 13, Chapter 13.28 that establishes wastewater surcharges to an industrial user whose discharge waste strength is in excess of the normal domestic strength wastewater pursuant to Section 13.28.40.

The surcharge fee shall apply to wastewater discharge strengths in excess of the surcharge threshold for the following key pollutants: total suspended solids (TSS) – three hundred (300) mg/L; biochemical oxygen demand (BOD5) – three hundred (300) mg/L; and phosphorus – five (5) mg/L. For discharges containing pollutant concentrations under these limits, there is no surcharge for that month for that pollutant. Discharges that exceed these limits shall be surcharged to recover the costs associated with treatment by the City's Water Reclamation Facility using the following formula and surcharge rates:

Concentration of pollutant over the threshold (mg/L) x Total flow (MGD) x 8.345 x (Surcharge (\$/lb.)

A Business Impact Statement was published in the Las Vegas Review Journal on July 30, 2020 and City Council approved the Business Impact Statement on September 16, 2020. The Utility Advisory Board reviewed this measure at its meeting on October 27, 2020 and recommends approval.
