STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The HOME Program is a flexible tool that helps local governments, along with State and non-profits, develop and support affordable housing for low income families. The \$1,000,000 projected award is contingent upon U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) final approval.

Application requests for funding these activities were submitted during the annual 2020-2021 HOME/AAHTF application cycle in November 2020. An internal City of North Las Vegas review team was assembled to review the applications. The review team consisted of a representative from the City Attorney's Office, Planning, Economic and Business Development, Public Works, and PAC divisions.

On November 17, 2020, a meeting was held where eligible applicants made presentations and responded to questions regarding their funding requests and concluded with a meeting on November 19, 2020 to prioritize and finalize their recommendations to City Council for the award of funds. The recommendations are listed in Exhibit A.
