STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

City staff and City Council have received a number of complaints about incidents of animal abuse, animal neglect, and animal cruelty. Similarly, City staff frequently receives complaints about feeding of pigeons at residential properties resulting in roosting and lingering of wild pigeons, which poses a health hazard.

To address these problems, City staff has prepared Ordinance No. 3053 to amend Title 6 of the North Las Vegas Municipal Code. These amendments address a number of issues. First, they criminalize the failure to provide animals with food, water, or veterinary care for illness, injury, disease, or infirmity, and require that animals kept outdoors be provided adequate shelter. Second, these amendments deem it unlawful for any person to feed wild pigeons. Third, the amendments to Title 6 establish a mechanism for owners of impounded animals to request a hearing with the Municipal Court.

City staff believes these amendments are necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of animals in our community and to comply with the Nevada Revised Statutes.

Therefore, Staff recommends that City Council introduce, approve, and adopt Ordinance No. 3053.
