Amend Section 6.08.060

To require impounded dogs, cats, potbellied pigs, ferrets and rabbits to be microchipped before being released



Amend Section 6.08.070

To provide that animals that have been impounded for Title 6 violations unclaimed by an owner after 72 hours of being impounded other than animal cruelty be deemed abandoned if they remain



Add Section 6.08.075

Provides a mechanism to transfer impounded animals owned or care possessed by an arrested or detained person and recovery of costs of



Add Chapter 6.09: General Welfare; Neglect

- Deems it unlawful for any person who has the care, custody, or veterinary care for illness, injury, disease, or infirmity possession of an animal to refuse or fail to provide food, water, or
- Requires that animals kept outdoors be provided adequate shelter
- temperature is expected to rise above 85 degrees Fahrenheit Requires that animals kept outdoors be provided shade when the
- expected to rise above 105 degrees Fahrenheit Requires a secondary cooling mechanism when the temperature is



Add Chapter 6.11: Nuisance

- public nuisance because of the health hazard they pose Establishes that roosting or lingering wild pigeons are considered a

Amend Section 6.12.020

suffering To revise the definition of animal cruelty to include failure to provide shelter, shade, or the veterinary attention needed to prevent protracted



Amend Section 6.12.070: Tethering

- To prohibit using a tether, chain, tie, or other device that places a dog in unsafe or unsanitary conditions
- dog access to food, water, shade, dry ground, or shelter To prohibit using a tether, tie or similar item that does not permit the
- during a 24-hour period more than 14 hours during a 24-hour period to no more than 10 hours To reduce the number of hours that a dog may be tethered, from no



Providing For Impounded Animals Due To Animal Cruelty **Add Section 6.12.100**

- Ensures compliance with NRS 574.055, which requires that Officers provide certain notice when impounding an animal
- Provides the owner an opportunity to request a hearing pursuant to NRS 574.203
- a hearing after five days of receiving the notice humanely destroyed, or continued in the care of the City if the owner does not request Provides a mechanism for Municipal Court to order that the animal be sold at auction,
- pursuant to NRS 574.203; identifies what evidence to consider at such a hearing Establishes when to hold a hearing if Municipal Court receives a request for a hearing
- Provides that any charges, fees, or costs incurred by the contracted animal shelter related to any animal being impounded shall be the responsibility of the animal's



Add Section 6.12.110

of NRS 574.070 or 574.100 impounded and its owner or caretaker is lawfully arrested for violations Provides a mechanism to request a hearing when an animal is



Add Section 6.12.200

hearing pursuant to NRS 574.203 Provides the various determinations of Municipal Court when holding a



Amend Section 6.13.040

- To regulate animals kept outdoors by operators
- temperature is expected to rise above 105 degrees Fahrenheit To require that animals kept outdoors be provided with adequate degrees Fahrenheit and a secondary cooling mechanism when the shelter and shade when the temperature is expected to rise above 85
