**SUBJECT:**

Approve First Amendment to the Interlocal Contract Annual Maintenance Work Program with the Clark County Regional Flood Control District, Funded by the Clark County Regional Flood Control District Which Increases the Amount of the Contract from \$2,154,427 to an Amount Not to Exceed \$2,331,000 to Include the Las Vegas Wash Between Owens Avenue and Lake Mead Boulevard. **RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:**

That the City Council approves the first amendment to the Interlocal Contract with the Clark County Regional Flood Control District to increase the funding of the original contract from \$2,154,427 to an amount not to exceed \$2,331,000 to include the Las Vegas Wash Middle between Owens Ave and Lake Mead Blvd (NLV19) funded by the Clark County Regional Flood Control District, for the annual maintenance work program which provides maintenance of flood control improvements within the City.

**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On June 11, 2020 the City of North Las Vegas entered into an Interlocal Contract with the Regional Flood Control District to maintain regional flood control facilities within the City of North Las Vegas. The locations of the facilities to be maintained are shown on Exhibit "A" of the proposed Interlocal Agreement, and the work to be performed is described in the work program which is attached.

This reach of Las Vegas Wash is within the jurisdiction of Clark County. An interlocal agreement between Clark County and North Las Vegas exists that provides for North Las Vegas to maintain this reach. As such, NLV19 is being added to the NLV maintenance budget.
