EXPLANATION:				
The above cost is the difference between the Developer required				
sewerline cost and the cost to construct the larger diameter sewerline				
requested by the City. The City's Capital Improvement Plan includes				
sewerline oversizing for the purpose of increasing the size of developer				
installed mains to provide additional capacity for future development.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Tropical Vegas Industrial Owner, LLC, at the request of the City, has agreed to construct 2,635 lineal feet of sewer main at a diameter larger than that required to serve its Project Falls development. The developer would have been required to construct an 8-inch main, where the City has requested that the developer install a 12-inch main to provide additional capacity for future development.

The North Las Vegas Municipal Code allows the city to reimburse the developer for the installation of the oversized sewer main, based on the difference in cost of the main installed and the cost of the main that the developer would have been required to install to serve its property alone. The difference in cost for the construction of the larger sewer main is \$525,579.99, which, if approved, will be reimbursed to the developer upon acceptance of the main by the City. Sewerline Oversizing is included in the City's Capital Improvement Plan for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 and is sufficient to cover the oversizing costs of this project. By oversizing developer sewer mains, additional capacity is provided for future development and the City's wastewater collection system develops in an orderly manner avoiding parallel mains and additional pavement cuts in the future.
