STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The projected FY 2021-2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) formula-based allocation is intended to be used to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing, a suitable living environment, and the expansion of economic opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons. The \$226,800 projected allocation is contingent upon the US Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) final approval.

The timeline for acceptance of the applications through the recommendation process is as follows:

October 6, 2020: The North Las Vegas Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) began the CDBG application process.

November 2, 2020: Applications were opened via ZoomGrants.
