SUBJECT:

Approve First Amendment to Agreement to Use Local Government Contract with Cintas Corporation No. 3, Which Increases the Amount of the Original Four-Year Agreement from \$1,448,000 to an Amount Not to Exceed \$1,756,000 for the Remaining Terms of the Agreement with an Option to Renew up to a Maximum of Two Two-Year Periods to Provide Cleaning Supplies, Uniforms, Floor Mats and Other Goods and Services for the City. That the City Council approve the First Amendment with Cintas Corporation No 3 in a total amount not to exceed \$1,756,000; \$225,000 annually for the remaining terms of the agreement for a four-year term ending October 31, 2023, with an option to renew for up to a maximum of two two-year periods, to provide cleaning supplies, uniforms, floor mats and other goods and services for the City.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Cintas and the Prince William County Manassas, Virginia entered into an agreement for Facilities Management Products and Solutions effective December 13, 2018. The City is a member of the OMNIA Partners Cooperative, and desires to purchase uniforms, facility services, first aid and safety products and uniform items, cleaning solutions, and laundry services for various City departments.
