STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This traffic signal project includes a fully functional permanent traffic signal, half street improvements, new pavement, removal and replacement of damaged pavement, curb returns, sidewalk ramps, pedestrian pathways, drainage improvements, signage, striping, utility adjustments and miscellaneous appurtenances required to complete the intersection of North 5th Street and Centennial Parkway.

Four bids were received on January 12, 2021, as detailed on the attached Bid Abstract. The lowest bid was submitted by Las Vegas Paving Corporation.

Las Vegas Paving Corporation is properly licensed and qualified to perform the work. The project is required to be completed within 240 calendar days following the issuance of the Notice-to-Proceed.

The award of this bid is subject to the approval and execution of the RTC supplemental funding agreement. Notice-to-Proceed with construction will not be issued until the interlocal funding contract is approved by the RTC Board and City Council.
