STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

EXPLANATION:

Utilities Enterprise Fund

The Central Reservoir Rehabilitation Project consists of remedial work to bring tanks 1, 2 and 4 into compliance with current water and safety codes, installation of new tank bottoms and cathodic protection systems and repainting the interior and exterior of the tanks. Tanks 1, 2 and 4 were built in 1963, 1970 and 1998, and have capacities of 3 million gallons, 3 million gallons and 7.5 million gallons respectively. Seven bids were received at the Bid Opening held on January 14, 2021, as detailed on the attached Bid Abstract. Olympus and Associates, Inc. submitted the best responsive bid and is properly licensed and qualified to perform the work.

Due to the complex nature of the tank repairs, coating systems and safety requirements, Bidders were asked to complete a detailed Bidder Qualification as part of their Bid Proposal. Monument Construction, Inc. submitted the lowest bid but was considered unqualified due to their lack of previous experience in tank repairs and coating.

The project is required to be completed within 330 calendar days following the issuance of the Notice-to-Proceed.

This project is funded by the Utility Enterprise Fund.
