STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This grant will enable the Police Department to conduct the "Pedestrian Safety, Awareness and Education" Program. The project activities will focus on modifying driver and pedestrian behavior and increasing the awareness of the dangers to pedestrians in traffic.

The Police Department will continue providing the safety awareness education campaign, called "Stop, Look and Listen". Fifteen participating elementary schools will receive instruction, continuing with the goal of teaching the program to all public elementary schools. Events are planned between October 2021 and September 2022.
