Approve submission and accept resulting award of a grant in the amount of \$ 176,827 from the State of Nevada, Department of Public Safety, Office of Traffic Safety, under the FFY2022 Pedestrian Safety Program for the Pedestrian Safety, Awareness and Education Program; and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the grant application and award documents.

AMOUNT: \$ 44,207

EXPLANATION:

Grant provides funds for overtime costs to educate and enforce the Pedestrian Safety Program.

Amount: \$ 221,034

Grant funds: \$ 176,827

In-kind match: \$ 44,207

Explanation: A local in-kind match of \$ 44,207 is required and funds will be budgeted in the Police Department's FY21-22 budget.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This grant will enable the Police Department to conduct the "Pedestrian Safety, Awareness and Education" Program. The project activities will focus on modifying driver and pedestrian behavior and increasing the awareness of the dangers to pedestrians in traffic.

The Police Department will continue providing the safety awareness education campaign, called "Stop, Look and Listen". Fifteen participating elementary schools will receive instruction, continuing with the goal of teaching the program to all public elementary schools. Events are planned between October 2021 and September 2022.
