STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Arterial Roadway Rehabilitation Program consists of the pavement rehabilitation strategies for aging arterial roadways in North Las Vegas. The Decatur Boulevard, Cheyenne Avenue to Rancho Drive construction project is generally located along Decatur Boulevard from Cheyenne Avenue to Rancho Drive as shown on the attached vicinity map.

Construction activities consists of the removal and replacement of damaged and failing Asphalt Concrete (AC), restriping the completed roadway, utility adjustments and other miscellaneous appurtenances required to complete this roadway.

Three bids were received at the bid opening held on February 9, 2021, as detailed on the attached Bid Abstract. The lowest bid was submitted by Aggregate Industries-SWR, Inc., who is properly licensed and qualified to perform the work. The project is required to be completed within ninety (90) consecutive calendar days following the issuance of the Notice-to-Proceed.
