STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On December 2, 2020, the City Council approved an emergency project for the installation of pressure relief valve at the intersection of Deer Springs Way and Goldfield Street. This project was funded by the Utility Enterprise Fund. Council authorized the City Manager to issue contracts as necessary to complete the work.

This project consisted of installing a pressure relief valve inside a vault, waterline and valve instations, asphalt patching, roadway striping, and all other appurtenances required.

The work was completed at an estimated cost not to exceed \$370,000. The project is now ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder.

The Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one year, effective March 18, 2021.
