<b>RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:</b> That Council pass, adopt, and authorize the Mayor to sign Resolution No. 2670 directed to the State of Nevada, Department of Transportation consenting to the relinquishment of a portion of Lake Mead Boulevard (SR-147) generally between Yale Street and Pecos Road to the City of North Las Vegas.

**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

To facilitate the maintenance of Lake Mead Boulevard and to allow the City complete control over future improvements, the State of Nevada, Department of Transportation (NDOT) proposes to relinquish to the City, Lake Mead Boulevard (SR-147) between Yale Avenue and Pecos Road, a total distance of 2.092 miles, more or less. NDOT has also contributed \$1.5 million to bring the roadway to an acceptable state of good repair to meet current City standards.

The attached resolution represents the State’s agreement with the City, pursuant to NRS 408.527, and establishes the specific limits of this relinquishment in order to avoid property right disputes and maintenance responsibilities in the future. In addition, the resolution is also the City’s consent to accept ownership and the responsibility to maintain a specific portion of Lake Mead Boulevard (SR-147).

As a result of the City taking control of Lake Mead Boulevard, future construction and events for City of North Las Vegas within the limits stated herein can occur without the need to gain approval from the State of Nevada, Department of Transportation for any necessary improvements or road closures.
