SUBJECT:

Approve First Amendment to the Purchase Agreement with Brenntag Pacific, Inc. Which Increases the Amount of the Agreement from \$2,244,000 to a Total of \$2,963,650 for the Remaining Term of the Agreement with One, Two-Year Extension at the Sole Discretion of the City Manager for the Wastewater Treatment Chemicals for the Water Reclamation Facility and the City's Swimming Pools. It is recommended that the City Council Approve the Amendment No. 1 to the Purchase Agreement with Brenntag Pacific, Inc.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On September 19, 2019, the City conducted a Bid (B-1585) for Wastewater and Swimming Pool Chemicals, which included six different chemicals as line items. The City selected Brenntag Pacific, Inc., because Brenntag was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for those five chemicals; Sodium Bisulfite, Hydrochloric Acid, LA Chemcolor Sodium Hypochlorite, Sodium Bicarbonate Industrial and Citric Acid. The unit cost for the Citric Acid for the WRF and the unit cost for the LA Chemcolor Sodium Hypochlorite for the Pools have both increased globally due to Covid-19 pandemic impacts to the supply chain.

Staff recommends that City Council approve Amendment No. 1 to the Purchase Agreement with Brenntag Pacific, Inc. to Increase the Total Amount of the Agreement by \$719,650 for a Total Amount of \$2,963,650 for all contract years, including the renewal terms, if exercised, for the Wastewater Treatment Chemicals for the Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) and the City's Swimming Pools.
