**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) for the North Las Vegas Police Supervisors Association (PSA) expired June 30, 2021. The City and the PSA have negotiated the terms and conditions of the new agreement. The new agreement will be in effect from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2024.

Pursuant to NRS 288.153, any new, extended or modified collective bargaining agreement between a local government employer and a union must be approved at a public hearing. The chief executive officer of the local government shall report to the local government the fiscal impact of the agreement. Furthermore, the City Charter requires City Council ratification of any collective bargaining agreement before it is effective.
