STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:				

The City owns two 16-inch waterlines that run through Nellis AFB. Throughout the years, some of the area where the waterlines are located have eroded due to flooding, and other environmental events. There are areas where the waterlines are exposed along with air release valves and water valves. These locations need to be protected and our Utilities Department needs access to these locations for maintenance purposes. City personnel will grade an access roadway in our easement to service the waterlines.

The location where this work is taking place is in an undeveloped desert area and law requires that an environmental consultant monitors the work to protect the desert tortoise, burrowing owl and other wildlife.

Staff recommends that the City Council Approve Professional Services Agreement with NewFields in an Amount Not to Exceed \$65,945 to Provide Environmental Support Services for Waterline Maintenance Within Nellis Air Force Base, Funded by the Utilities Enterprise Fund.
