STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City Council accepted the grant from the U.S. Department of the Treasury under the American Rescue Plan Act State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund at the City's September 1, 2021 meeting. The City is recommending that \$458,660.00 of the funds be subgranted to the Nevada System of Higher Education, Board of Regents, on behalf of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas ("UNLV") for UNLV to establish and administer a Small Business Development and Support Center on the first floor of City Hall.

UNLV shall provide a number of essential services to businesses in the community to promote entrepreneurship, small business growth, the southern Nevada economy, and economic recovery from the negative impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on businesses and workers by providing guidance to small business owners through advisory sessions, workshops, and facilitating connections to resources.
