STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City owns certain real property at 2250 Las Vegas Boulevard North, North Las Vegas, Nevada 89030. The Nevada System of Higher Education, Board of Regents, on behalf of University of Nevada, Las Vegas ("UNLV") wishes to lease four hundred fifty-five square feet of office space located on the first floor of City Hall, as more particularly described in Exhibit A, attached hereto (the "Premises"), to operate a satellite office of the UNLV Small Business Development Center ("UNLV SBDC") to promote entrepreneurship, small business growth, the southern Nevada economy and economic recovery from the negative economic effects resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic by providing guidance to small business owners through advisory sessions, workshops, and facilitating connections to resources. The City wishes to lease the Premises to UNLV to further its Mission, which will provide a benefit to the City and residents.

Pursuant to NRS 268.064(1), the City may offer any portion of a City-owned building for lease without offering the property to the public and for less than the fair market value of the building space if the building space is less than 25,000 square feet and the City adopts a resolution determining that leasing the building space is in the best interest of the City. Additionally, the City must publish a notice setting forth a description of the property to be leased and hold a public hearing on the matter pursuant to NRS 268.064(2).

The proposed lease is for a three-year term with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year terms upon mutual agreement, for no rent as long as UNLV continuously pursues its Mission for the benefit of the public.

Staff recommends that Council pass and adopt Resolution No. 2676.
