STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Neighborhood Roadway Rehabilitation Fiscal Year 2020 Project consisted of the pavement rehabilitation strategies for several aging collector and local roadways in North Las Vegas as shown on the attached vicinity map. The method of pavement rehabilitation generally consisted of removal and replacement of pavement, installation of crack sealant, slurry seal, replacing pavement striping, and other related improvements.

On February 19, 2020, City Council awarded the construction contract for the Neighborhood Roadway Rehabilitation Fiscal Year 2020 Project to Aggregate Industries-SWR, Inc. in the amount of \$3,549,263.00. On October 21, 2020, City Council approved Construction Change Order No. 1 to increase funds by \$100,000 to address an unforeseen increase in quantity of asphaltic concrete and slurry seal needed to complete the project. The total revised construction contract was \$3,649,263.00.

This project was completed under budget at a total cost of \$3,582,760.06 and is now ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the Project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder. As per the Contract, the Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one year, effective December 7, 2020.
