SUBJECT:

Approve Second Amendment to the Installation, Repair, Rental and Reconstruction of Chain Link Fencing, Gate, and Similar Types City-Wide Service Agreement with The Tiberti Fence Company, Which Increases the Amount of the Agreement from \$1,229,495 to an Amount Not to Exceed \$1,376,995 with the Option to Renew for Two Additional One-Year Periods at the City Manager's Discretion. RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

That City Council approve the second amendment to the service agreement with Tiberti Fence Company, which increases the amount of the agreement from \$1,229,495 to a total amount not to exceed \$1,376,995 (\$240,000 per fiscal year for the remaining term and optional periods of the contract effective January 16, 2020) for the installation, repair, rental, and reconstruction of chain link fencing, gates, and similar types Citywide.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On January 16, 2020, City Council awarded Bid B1583 and approved the Citywide fencing agreement with Tiberti Fence Company. This agreement is for installation, repair, rental, and reconstruction of chain link fencing, gates, and similar types Citywide. .

The increase is necessary due to the increased homeless encampment cleanup, increased vehicle crashes and accidents, increased fencing repair, and increased redevelopment demolition projects.

Any repairs done at the Flood Channels and Detention Basins are reimbursable by the Clark County Regional Flood Control District.
