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## SUBJECT:

Approve Services Agreement with Southern Nevada TBA Supply Co. Inc. dba Ted Wiens Auto Center for Goodyear and Bridgestone/Firestone Tire Products Utilizing NASPO Agreement Pricing in a Total Amount Not to Exceed \$325,000 for a Three-Year Term with Two Possible One-Year Extensions, Using the Competitive Bidding Exception Per NRS 332.195(1)(a). ## RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

That City Council approve a Services Agreement with Ted Wiens Auto Center for Goodyear and Bridgestone/Firestone tire products utilizing NASPO agreement pricing in a total amount not to exceed the initial term of (3) years at \$195,000.00 or \$65,000 per year. A total not to exceed value with all extension at \$325,000 using the competitive bidding exception per NRS 332.195(1)(a) which permits the City to enter into a contract pursuant to a solicitation by a governmental entity located within or outside this State with the authorization of the contracting vendor.

AMOUNT: \$325,000 ACCOUNT NUMBER: 750-160113-420312

FISCAL IMPACT: Three-year Services Agreement with Ted Wiens Auto Center at \$65,000 per fiscal year with the option of renewal for an additional two, one-year periods.

Amount: \$65,000 for FY 2021-2022

EXPLANATION: This amount is approved in the annual Fleet Operations'

Service and Supplies budget for Garage Auto expenditures.

## STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Fleet purchases vehicle tires, as needed for vehicles throughout its entire fleet, as part of preventive maintenance and to increase vehicle safety. This agreement with Ted Wiens Auto Center allows Fleet Operations to receive government approved pricing through NASPO. Fleet Operations establishes a budget for supplies such as tires each fiscal year. The funding utilized in this agreement has already been set aside and spending patterns for multiple years support these costs.

NRS 332.195(1)(a), which permits the City to enter into a contract pursuant to a solicitation by a governmental entity located within or outside this State with the authorization of the contracting vendor, allows the City to forgo the standard competitive bidding procedure.
