STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The HOME Investment Partnership Act (HOME) is a federal and state funded program for affordable housing. Funds are allocated by formula to participating jurisdictions (state and local governments) to expand and improve the supply of affordable housing in our jurisdiction. All funds allocated must be used to benefit individuals and families whose incomes do not exceed 80% of the area median income (or lower), as defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Approval of the Interlocal Agreement with Clark County, Nevada will allow Clark County to reimburse eligible grant expenditures undertaken by the City and its contracted agencies. This Interlocal Agreement is renewed on annual basis.

Approval of this Interlocal Agreement is required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) prior to reimbursement by Clark County to the City for Program 2022/2023 expenditures.

NOTE: This agreement, developed by Clark County, refers to the fiscal year of 2021-2022; this is the Clark County naming convention. In contrast, the City of North Las Vegas refers to this same period (FY 2021-2022)
