That City Council approve the purchase of two (2) Utility Trucks with Crane built to North Las Vegas specifications outlined in Bid Number B-1657. This Utility Crew Truck with Crane Purchase Agreement is for a not to exceed total of \$525,760 (For Possible Action).

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City issued BID B-1657 and Cobalt Truck Equipment LLC. was the lowest and most responsive bidder.

The City desires to purchase two (2) Utility Trucks with Cranes built to North Las Vegas specifications outlined in Bid Number B-1657. This Utility Crew Truck with Crane Purchase Agreement is for a not to exceed total of \$525,760. Any miscellaneous items will be done through Fleet, outside of the contract.

This request is to purchase replacement vehicles for (2) 2007 GMC C5500 trucks that have reached their life expectancies due to age, mileage, and high maintenance and repair costs. At Fleets discretion, the vehicles being replaced will be sent to auction, used as reserve vehicles or used for parts. This is dependent upon the condition of the vehicles at the time of replacement.

In an effort to reduce costs and vehicle downtime, Fleet recommends replacing these vehicles immediately to avoid adverse impacts to Fleet's budget and the operations of both Fleet and the Utilities Department.
