STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The improvements will begin at a flood control facility on Alexander Road west of Decatur Boulevard, extend eastward along Alexander Road and transition to an existing flood control facility at Simmons Street. These improvements will reduce erosion, reduce maintenance, and improve safety. The improvements consist of approximately 8,500 linear feet of reinforced concrete box, transition and junction structures.

The improvements will also consist of roadway reconstruction along Alexander Road, utility relocations, streetlight LED conversion, striping, and all other appurtenances as necessary to return the streets to full use.

At the bid opening on April 7, 2022, three bids were received and Las Vegas Paving Corporation submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid with a total bid of \$49,249,925. The lowest bid exceeded the Engineer's Cost Estimate of \$38,659,980 due to escalating construction costs, especially in cement and reinforcing steel.

Las Vegas Paving Corporation has adequate staff and expertise to perform the work and has successfully
