STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On December 16, 2020, the City Council awarded a construction contract to Fisher Sand & Gravel Corporation in the amount of \$11,489,489.00 for the Beltway Detention Basin and Channel Project. The Project consisted of constructing a flood control detention basin with inflow channels, outflow channels, and culverts. This project is located east of the intersection of Centennial Parkway and North Lamb Boulevard in North Las Vegas, Nevada 89115.

On January 5, 2022, City Council approved Construction Change Order No. 1 to increase funds by \$450,000.00 to address an unforeseen increase in the quantities of rock mulch. The change order brought the revised construction contract total to \$11,939,489.00.

The work was completed on time and under budget at a total cost of \$11,864,425.56. The project is now ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder.

The Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one-year, effective February 28, 2022.
