**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On October 6, 2021, the City Council approved a Memorandum of Understanding to amend the Collective Bargaining Agreement recognizing Juneteenth as a holiday in our community and for our team members in response to the President of the United States signing into law the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act on June 17, 2021, recognizing Juneteenth as a public holiday on June 19th to commemorate the emancipation of African-American slaves proclaiming freedom on June 19, 1865.

The attached memorandum of understanding memorializes the tentative agreement between the City and The North Las Vegas Police Officers Association amending the following agreements:

- 2021-2024 Corrections Non-Supervisor Agreement Between the City of North Las Vegas and The North Las Vegas Police Officers Association

The amendment strikes “June 19 (Juneteenth)” and replaces it with “Third Monday in June (Juneteenth).”
