**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On June 16, 2021, the City Council awarded a construction contract to Harber Company, Inc. dba Mountain Cascade of Nevada in the amount of \$8,992,622.00 for the Hollywood System – Centennial Parkway to Speedway #2 Detention Basin Project. Project improvements consisted of flood facilities including pipes, channels, dikes, energy dissipators, channel structures, channel access and other appurtenances to control floodwaters. The improvements roughly follow the Hollywood Boulevard alignment from Centennial Parkway, transverse under the I-15 freeway, to the existing Speedway #2 Detention Basin.

The work was completed on time and under budget at a total cost of \$8,813,574.29. The project is now ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder.

The Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one-year, effective May 2, 2022.
