STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Fire Department has had a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management for nearly a decade to provide personnel and assets when available/requested to major wildland fires throughout the western United States. The City and BLM are entering into the 2022 Operating Plan pursuant to their existing agreements and the 2022 Operating Plan defines operating procedures and responsibilities within the framework of the parties' existing agreements. The 2022 Operating Plan details the provision of mutual aid and reimbursement to allow the City to provide rapidly deploy personnel and assets in wildland fire incidents overseen by the BLM.
