STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of North Las Vegas’ (“City”) mission is “to create and sustain ‘Your Community of Choice’ for its residents, visitors, and businesses. The City is committed to being a balanced and well-planned community that provides quality municipal services, education, housing, recreation and leisure opportunities, economic vitality, security, public safety, strong community partnerships, civic pride for a culturally rich, active, and diverse population.”

In line with the City’s mission, City staff is working to open the Dolores Huerta Resource Center. The resource center will provide opportunities for education, advocacy, and will aim to help elevate quality of life for all City residents.

Hispanics represent 41% of the North Las Vegas population, many of whom are Spanish-speakers. Accordingly, services at the Dolores Huerta Resource Center will also be available in Spanish.
