STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Funds Re-Allocation

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) COVID formula-based allocation is intended to be used to prevent, prepare, and respond to the spread of the coronavirus. City Council approved the original allocation of the CDBG Round 3 COVID at its December 16, 2020 meeting. The agreements for the funds allocated to mortgage assistance will expire on September 30, 2022. Housing and Neighborhood Services staff is requesting that the unspent balance of the mortgage assistance program funds be reallocated to the following programs: Three Square Pop Up Pantry Program - \$85,000; CNLV Neighborhood and Leisure Services Senior Meals 2 You Program - \$120,000; and CPLC, Inc. Small Business Forgivable Loan Program - \$469,000. These programs are in high demand in North Las Vegas because of the continued economic strain from the pandemic.
