STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:			

In November of 2019, the City approved the Rule 9 Line Extension Agreement with NV Energy that was funded with HUD CDBG Program Funds. The CDBG funds were approved specifically for the CIP Library Project. Due to the recent fire that damaged the building that was to become the Downtown Library and various circumstances, including the lack of available CDBG funds needed to repair the fire damaged building, the Redevelopment Agency and the City have cancelled the project.

The previously approved Rule 9 Line Extension Agreement with NVE was executed and the fee was paid to NVE with CDBG funds. However, since the CIP Library Project was cancelled, all HUD CDBG funds expended on the project to date have to be repaid to HUD. The RDA wishes to continue moving forward with the Rule 9 Line Expansion project and construction of undergrounding the poles to create development-ready parcels that are owned by the Redevelopment Agency. Therefore, staff recommends that RDA reimburse the HUD CDBG funds in the amount of \$419,703 so that the project under the Rule 9 Line Extension Agreement with NV Energy can still go forward.
