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RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:
Approve Agreement to Replace Playground Surface at Craig Ranch Regional Park and authorize the issuance of a purchase order in the amount of $\$ 74,440$ to Robertson Installations L.L.C.

EXPLANATION:
The installation of new playground surfacing will be paid with no impact to the City's general fund using revenue generated through parks and picnic shelter rentals.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:
The original playground surface was installed in 2010, with an expected lifespan of seven to ten years. Through regular preventative maintenance, staff was able to extend the lifespan to ten years; however, the most recent audit by a third-party playground inspector, determined that the surface has reached the end of its useful life and should be replaced.

Estimates for the replacement of the surfacing were solicited from Evans Recreation, Robertson Installations L.L.C, Robertson Recreational Surfaces, Creative Play and Spectraturf. Robertson Installations L.L.C. was the lowest responsive bidder with a price of $\$ 9.30$ per square foot $(\$ 74,440)$. Robertson Installations L.L.C. has performed several jobs at North Las Vegas parks and has been a responsible and reliable vendor.

Staff recommends the timely approval of this agreement to replace approximately 8,000 square feet of playground surfacing.
