**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Sewer Main Rehabilitation – Losee Road and Cheyenne Avenue Project consists of the installation of approximately 10,170 linear feet of 15-inch, 18-inch, 21-inch and 33-inch Cured In Place Pipe LIner along Losee Road, approximately 2,325 linear feet of 15-inch slip line pipe along Cheyenne Avenue and the installation of corrosion protection in 23 sewer manholes. This project is part of the continuing program to rehabilitate deteriorating sewer lines, improve flows, and reduce maintenance costs.

Two bids were received at the bid opening held on October 13, 2020, as detailed on the attached Bid Abstract. The lowest Base Bid plus Additive Alternate No. 1 was submitted by Las Vegas Paving Corporation. The Base Bid and Additive Alternate No. 1 are to be awarded.

Las Vegas Paving Corporation is properly licensed and qualified to perform the work. The project is required to be completed within 240 calendar days following the issuance of the Notice-to-Proceed.

\$4,092,870 in Clean Water State Revolving Funds are available for this project. The remaining \$1,971,000 will be provided from the Utility Fund with an augmentation of the FY20/21 Capital Budget.
