It is recommended on December 16, 2020, that City Council approve the HOME Application Review Team recommendation for the project award of \$1,000,000 in program year 2020-2021 HOME Investment Partnerships Program grant awards and State Account for Affordable Housing Trust Fund Awards; also to Authorize the City Manager or his designee to enter into appropriate agreements of approved programs and projects as required and administratively approve any revised final funding allocations.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The HOME Program is a flexible tool that helps local governments, along with State and non-profits, develop and support affordable housing for low income families. The \$1,000,000 projected award is contingent upon U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) final approval.

Application requests for funding these activities were submitted during the annual 2020-2021 HOME/AAHTF application cycle in November 2020. An internal City of North Las Vegas review team was assembled to review the applications. The review team consisted of a representative from the City Attorney's Office, Planning, Economic and Business Development, Public Works, and PAC divisions.

On November 17, 2020, a meeting was held where eligible applicants made presentations and responded to questions regarding their funding requests and concluded with a meeting on November 19, 2020 to prioritize and finalize their recommendations to City Council for the award of funds. The recommendations are listed in Exhibit A.
