**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Central Reservoir Tanks 1, 2, and 4 Rehabilitation Project consists of cleaning and repainting of the reservoir's interior and exterior surfaces, removal and replacement of the tank floors, as well as the installation and refurbishment of other tank appurtenances.

This tank project must meet specific public water safety guidelines and requires special construction and inspection services to ensure the proper oversight is completed. Staff negotiated an Agreement for construction phase support with A 2 Z NDT Inspection Services to perform pre-coating inspections, coating inspections, non-destructive testing, and welding inspections in a not-to-exceed amount of \$448,473.00.

Construction is set to begin in March 2021 and is anticipated be complete in late March 2022. The construction duration for this project is 365 calendar days.
