RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION: That the City Council approve the Interlocal Contract with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, as authorized under NRS 277.180, for the purpose of being a subrecipient of funds made available by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, under the FY20 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program, CFDA #16.543, in the amount of \$38,015 and Authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the documents.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program (ICAC program) helps state and local law enforcement agencies develop an effective response to cyber enticement and child pornography cases. This help encompasses forensic and investigative components, training and technical assistance, victim services, and community education.

The ICAC program is a national network of coordinated task forces representing over 2,000 federal, state, and local law enforcement and prosecutorial agencies. These agencies are engaged in proactive investigations, forensic investigations, and criminal prosecutions. By helping state and local agencies to develop effective, sustainable responses to online child victimization and child pornography, the Office of Justice Programs has increased their capacity to address internet crimes against children.
