**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On July 24, 2020, the City requested a quote for the replacement of an Eaton Ampgard starter for the WRF process blower. This service involves the retrofit of the electrical cabinet to accommodate the latest model starter, the commissioning of the equipment, and preparation of as-built drawings. This service is necessary to replace the unrepairable starter which has left the Water Reclamation Facility without a secondary blower motor starter.

The City has identified Eaton Corporation as the sole source vendor approved to perform maintenance on Eaton equipment. Staff has reviewed their quote and determined they are qualified to complete the work.

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the service agreement with Eaton Corporation in the not to exceed amount of \$59,590.00, and an additional supplemental amount not to exceed \$6,000.00 for the replacement of the blower motor starter at the Water Reclamation Facility, for a total of \$ 65,590.00.
