That City Council approve the second amendment to the heavy equipment rental agreement with Cashman Equipment Company which increases the amount of the agreement from an amount not to exceed \$1,020,000 over the term of the agreement including all renewal terms to an amount not to exceed \$1,420,000 over the term of the agreement including all renewal terms.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On February 7, 2018, City Council approved the Heavy Equipment Rental Agreement with Cashman Equipment Company for the rental of heavy equipment for use on various projects including emergencies by the City of North Las Vegas as well as Flood and Development Control. The first amendment to increase the contract amount was approved on February 26, 2020. PW-Roadway is seeking for additional amount to increase the annual spending due to the increase in the rental needs for homeless encampment cleanup, City-owned vehicles being inoperable and/or being repaired, and the City taking over additional Flood Channel Facilities from Clark County to maintain.
