SUBJECT:

Approve Removal, Purchase and Installation Services Agreement with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC; and Authorize Issuance of a Purchase Order in an Amount of \$394,000 Using Competitive Bidding Exceptions Per NRS 332 & 338 for the Purchase and Installation of a Stadium Lighting System for Cheyenne Sports Complex, CIP Project No. 10475. That the City Council approve an agreement with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in an amount of \$394,000 and authorize the issuance of a purchase order in that amount.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Stadium at the Cheyenne Sports Complex has a lighting system that was installed over 30 years ago that requires replacement. The surrounding community utilizes both the stadium and surrounding track on a regular basis, and a new lighting system will allow additional access at night which will also assist the City in allocating the stadium to generate revenue. During recent windstorms, components of the stadium's lighting system blew over and the City has engaged Musco Lighting to remove parts of the lighting system.

Musco Sports Lighting is an industry-leading supplier of sports lighting and the City utilizes Musco Sports Lighting products at many City parks. Given the exigent circumstances related to the windstorm, the City may engage Musco Lighting to remove and install a new lighting system under NRS 332.112 (1)(b) and NRS 338.011 (2). Additionally, the competitive bidding exceptions in NRS 338.115 (1)(a), 338.115(1)(c), and 338.115(1)(d) apply because the lighting system utilizes proprietary technology only available to Musco Lighting and the City maintains an inventory of replacement parts that are compatible with existing City sports lighting systems.
