**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

This Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 1 (1081) has recently been approved by the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC).

The City of Las Vegas is the lead agency for the design of the Lake Mead Boulevard, Simmons Street to Losee Road Project, which is located partially in the City of North Las Vegas (CNLV) and City of Las Vegas (CLV). This contract allocated funds for CLV to complete the project and to coordinate design and construction of the project with CNLV staff.

Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 1 increases project funds for the CLV to cover costs for additional engineering and right-of-way.

A separate interlocal contract to reimburse CNLV staff for time on this project was executed in July of 2019.

This project is funded by the RTC.
