STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Civic Center Drive, Carey Avenue to Cheyenne Avenue project involves the design, right of way acquisition and construction of corridor enhancements to include pedestrian improvements and pavement rehabilitation.

This project is currently built-out from its right-of-way limits that provides for four (4) lanes of travel, two (2) in each direction. Various ancillary improvements have taken place since its inception over three decades ago that include landscaped medians and mid-block crossings. The work herein will mitigate roadway deficiencies, provide for uniformity, address accessibility, improve multi-modal mobility, and provide opportunities for aesthetic improvements by way of incorporating the Complete Street Design Concept. In particular, such work will perpetuate the full width, continuous roadway to include modifications to the curb, gutter, sidewalk, pavement rehabilitation for areas identified as being distressed, and remove and replace various wall and fences.

A selection committee evaluated and ranked Statements of Qualifications from engineering firms to establish the current Transportation Engineering qualifications list. WSP, USA, Inc. was selected from this qualifications list to provide professional design services for this project.

Public Works staff negotiated this professional design services fee not to exceed \$809,522 to provide design, bid phase support, and engineering construction management support upon award of the construction contract..
