STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On November 6, 2019, City Council awarded construction contract for the Major Corridor Pavement Markings Replacement FY20 Project. This project is an annual on-call services contract for the repair, removal and installation of pavement markings and providing associated traffic control in various locations on major corridors within North Las Vegas.

As outlined in the project specifications, Special Conditions, Page SC-1, SC 1.0 Contract Description, D, this contract has an option for (2) two, (1) one-year) contract extensions. The approval criteria for this extension is based on contractor performance, timely completion of work, and North Las Vegas representative and management approval. The current annual contract expiration is June 30, 2021 and staff is recommending a (1) one year extension of this annual contract for 2022.

This is an annual on-call Contract and, if extended, will be in effect from July 1, 2021 until June 30, 2022.
