STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On January 20, 2021, the City Council approved two emergency projects for the installation of line stops, valve replacements and repair of a pressure relief valve on Lamb Blvd, between Azure Ave. and Centennial Pkwy., and at Arnold Loop at Nellis Air Force Base. These projects were funded by the Utility Enterprise Fund. Council authorized the City Manager to issue contract as necessary to complete the Work.

The Lamb Blvd PRV work is complete and consisted of installing $2 \sim 24$ inch line stops, removing and replacing $2 \sim 24$ inch valves and $2 \sim 6$ inch valves, repairing a damaged pressure relief valve inside a vault, asphalt patching, roadway striping, and all other appurtenances required.

The work was completed at an estimated cost not to exceed \$220,000. The project is now ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder.

The Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one year, effective March 23, 2021.
