STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

At their meeting of March 10, 2021, the Planning Commission recommended to approve ZN-34-2020 (6-1 vote). Commissioner J. D. Calhoun made the motion to approve. Commissioner Lamont Riley opposed the motion.

The applicant is requesting consideration to reclassify (rezone) the subject property from the C-1, Neighborhood Commercial District to a PUD/PID, Planned Unit Development District/Planned Infill Development District) to allow a 59-unit, senior multi-family complex on 2.55 gross acres with a density of 23.14 dwelling units per acre. The site is located west of Valley Drive, approximately 270 feet south of Craig Road. The Comprehensive Master Plan is Mixed-Use Commercial.
