SUBJECT:

Approve Third Amendment to the Heavy Equipment Rental Agreement with ECCO Equipment Company, LLC, Which Increases the Amount of the Agreement from an Amount Not to Exceed \$800,000; \$200,000 Annually to an Amount Not to Exceed \$1,040,000; \$320,000 Annually for the Remaining Year on the Existing Agreement with the Option to Renew for One Additional One-Year Period at the Discretion of the City Manager for Heavy Equipment Rentals. RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

That City Council approve the Third Amendment to the Agreement with ECCO Equipment Company, LLC for heavy equipment rentals, which will increase spending authority for an amount not to exceed \$800,000; \$200,000 annually, to an amount not to exceed \$1,040,000; \$320,000 annually for the remaining year on the existing contract ending February 6, 2022, with the option to renew for one additional one-year period at the discretion of the City Manager.

\$500,000 Original contract (three year term, with option to renew for two additional one-year periods; \$100,000 annually)
 \$250,000 First Amendment (increased annual amount from \$100,000 to \$150,000)
 \$50,000 Second Amendment (increased annual amount from \$150,000 to \$200,000 for the remainder of the term and two additional one-year periods)
 \$120,000 Third Amendment (increased annual amount from \$200,000 to \$320,000 for the remainder of the term and one additional one-year period)
 \$1,040,000 Total revised contract amount

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On February 7, 2018, City Council approved the Heavy Equipment Rental Agreement with ECCO Equipment Company, LLC for the rental of heavy equipment for use on various projects including emergencies and flood and development control. Heavy equipment is critical to meet the daily objectives of maintaining safe roadway conditions, flood channels, and detention basin.

The proposed increase is necessary due to the increased activities on roadway, flood, and detention basins, and other projects, such as the opening of the Community Correctional Center, the old Fire Station 53 being renovated as the new Youth Harbor Center, and other citywide projects.
