**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Southern Nevada Area Communications Council (SNACC) was formed in 1995 by a Cooperative Agreement between Clark County and the Las Vegas Valley Water District. Since then, the Water Reclamation District, the four major cities in the Las Vegas area, the Clark County School District, and the Regional Transportation Commission have become members of SNACC. Specifically, the City of North Las Vegas joined in July 1997. SNACC provides a radio backbone system with transmitters and repeaters that deliver an 800 megahertz radio service which provides interoperable communications among numerous government agencies within Clark County.

All two-way radio users employed with the City of North Las Vegas utilize the Southern Nevada Area Communications Council (SNACC) radio system. These annual fees will be utilized by SNACC for operating costs of maintaining the system.
