**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

North Las Vegas has been awarded \$46,340,548 in SLFRF from the US Treasury to support the immediate pandemic response, bring back jobs, and lay the groundwork for a strong and equitable recovery. 50% of the funding has been disbursed to the City, with the remaining 50% scheduled for disbursement in May 2022. Funding can be used for a variety of allowable expenses, including: Supporting public health expenditures; addressing negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency; replacing lost public sector revenue; providing premium pay for essential workers; and investing in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure. Funds from the grant must be encumbered (allocated) by December 31, 2024 and projects supported by the funding must be complete by December 31, 2026.
